UNDERSTANDING YOUR HEALTH RESOURCES

FLORIDA KIDCARE



Florida's high-quality, low-cost health insurance for children. KidCare matches each child with their best fit of the four Florida KidCare programs based on:

- Child's Age
- Household Size
- Family Income

All children above the age of 1 are eligible for Florida KidCare coverage through a subsidized or full-pay program, even if one or both parents are working. To qualify for premium assistance, also known as subsidized coverage, a child must:

- Be under age 19
- Be uninsured when Florida KidCare coverage begins
- Meet income eligibility requirements
- Be a U.S. citizen or qualified non-citizen (a parent's immigration status will never be asked.)
- Not be eligible for fully-subsidized Medicaid
- Not be in a public institution

PINELLAS COUNTY HEALTH PLAN ENROLLMENT (BLUE CARD)



Pinellas County residents enrolled in a PCHP receive free routine primary medical care at a "Medical Home" by PCHP's providers. No more ER visits and long wait times for routine medical care. Your Medical Home provides easy access to medical staff through same-day office appointments.

Doctors are on call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week for emergencies.

You may be eligible if you:

- Are a legal permanent resident or citizen of the United States.
- Are a Pinellas County resident.
- Are between the ages of 18 and 64. You can not get services if you are 65 years old or older.
- Meet federal poverty guidelines for income (100% or less).
- Are uninsured and can not pay for the medical care you need.
- Are not eligible for Medicaid, Medicare, or another assistance program

UNDERSTANDING YOUR HEALTH RESOURCES

AFFORDABLE CARE ACT

You may qualify for financial help to get your health plan on the Health Insurance Marketplace (popularly known as Obamacare). If the enrollment period has ended for the year (it's usually in the fall and early winter), you may qualify for a special enrollment period.

MEDICARE

Medicare beneficiaries in Florida may choose to receive their coverage from Medicare, Part A and Part B, or through a Medicare approved insurance company that offers Medicare Advantage plans. Original Medicare, Part A and Part B, is federally funded health insurance available to all eligible Medicare beneficiaries. Part A provides inpatient hospital care while Part B covers doctor's services and durable medical equipment. Some beneficiaries may choose to receive their benefits through a Medicare Advantage plan, also known as Medicare Part C. Medicare Part D Prescription Drug Plans provide stand-alone prescription drug coverage to Medicare beneficiaries. To qualify for Medicare, you must be either a United States citizen or a legal permanent resident of at least five continuous years. Florida residents may be enrolled automatically a few months before they reach age 65, provided they already receive benefits through the Social Security Administration (SSA) or the Railroad Retirement Board (RRB). Others may be enrolled sooner if they receive SSA disability benefits or certain disability benefits. Learn more at: <http://www.floridashine.org>

MEDICAID

Medicaid is the medical assistance program that provides access to health care for low-income families and individuals. Medicaid also assists the elderly and people with disabilities with the costs of nursing facility care and other medical and long-term care expenses. UNDERSTANDING YOUR HEALTH RESOURCES

FEDERALLY QUALIFIED HEALTH CENTERS (FQHC'S)

Federally qualified health centers offer comprehensive services (such as family and pediatric medicine, obstetrics and gynecology care, dental care, emergency health services, prescriptions, and referrals). They accept most major insurances and offer a sliding fee scale based on income.

FREE & LOW COST CLINICS

These clinics can help low-income and uninsured people by offering free and discounted rates for medical services and/or dental care. You cannot currently have health insurance, including Medicare/Medicaid, county social services, or VA benefits.

PINELLAS COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT

The Pinellas County Department of Health offers medical and dental services on a sliding scale for children, teens, and adults living at 101-200% of the federal poverty level. Fees are based on the declared income of the child's family or the individual. Medicaid clients are welcome.

UNDERSTANDING YOUR HEALTH RESOURCES

URGENT CARE

When a patient needs to see a physician urgently, but does not have a life threatening condition, and their doctors or specialist are not able to accommodate an immediate appointment, urgent care is the answer. It is often times cheaper to go to an urgent care clinic, rather than the ER, where wait times may also be longer. Call ahead to see what insurance they accept. Also includes fee for service for uninsured patients.

HEALTH TERMS YOU SHOULD KNOW

NETWORK

Your network is made up of the facilities and doctors your health insurer (insurance company) has contracted with to provide you with health care services. Your insurer wants you to use doctors that are a part of their network. Using providers **IN-NETWORK** lets you • Save on medical expenses • Choose from a limited group of primary care doctors, facilities, and specialists • Avoid paying higher co-pays, deductibles, and co-insurance payments than if you choose a provider **OUT-OF-NETWORK**

PREMIUM

This is the monthly amount you pay for your insurance. If you do not pay it in a timely manner, you could lose your coverage.

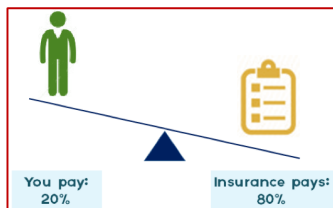
PRIMARY CARE DOCTOR

This is your regular doctor responsible for helping you maintain your health. It is up to you to schedule an appointment for preventative care or when you are sick.

CO-INSURANCE

This is separate from premiums and deductibles. Most insurance companies have some form of co-insurance, in which the insurance company pays for a percentage of the cost of medical treatment & you pay the rest.

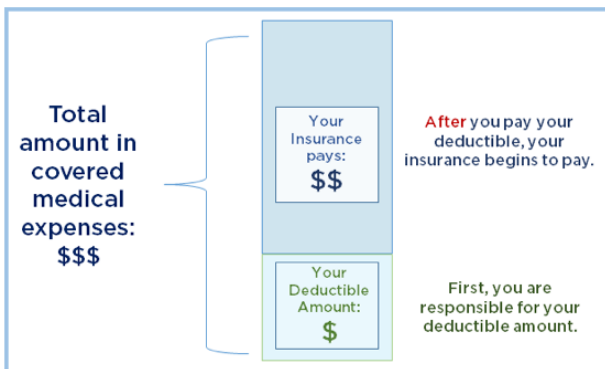
Example: If your plans allowed amount for an office visit is \$100 & you have met your deductible, and you have a co-insurance payment of 20%, you would pay \$20. Your plan will pay the rest



HEALTH TERMS YOU SHOULD KNOW

DEDUCTIBLE

The amount of expenses that must be paid out of pocket before an insurer will pay for any expenses. You can still always see your primary care doctor for the cost of your co-pay.



COPAY

This is a fixed amount you pay in advance for a covered health service. The fixed amount changes for different plans & types of services. Usually a co-pay is required for each visit.

Example: If your primary care co-pay is \$20, you will pay \$20 for each visit.

OUT OF POCKET MAXIMUM

This is the most you will have to pay during a policy period (usually a year) before your plan begins to pay 100% of covered benefits.
